## COARSEGOLD RODEO/ GROUNDS/COMMITTEE RELEASE OF LIABILITY

As consideration for being allowed to compete/participate for the Coarsegold Rodeo Mutton Bustin' and/or any horse related event and/or any Coarsegold Rodeo related event at, or associated with the Coarsegold Rodeo Grounds, the undersigned agrees fully to the following:

### PARTICIPANT:

We acknowledge that horseback riding and rodeo events are sports which carry inherent risks of injury and damage to me, my horse and property. We knowingly assume all risks, whether known or unknown, of horseback riding and rodeo events.

I hereby release **Kevin and Tanner Tweed, and Coarsegold Rodeo/Grounds/Committee** from all liability for any act of negligence or want of ordinary care on the part of the owners, officers, directors, volunteers, members and/or sponsors and advertisers or any of its agents. In consideration of my participation in events organized or sponsored by **Kevin and Tanner Tweed, and Coarsegold Rodeo/Grounds/Committee**, we waive, release and discharge **Kevin and Tanner Tweed, and Coarsegold Rodeo/Grounds/Committee**, their owners, directors, agents, volunteers and members, their representatives, heirs, executors and assigns from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals or my property arising out of my participation. This agreement is binding upon my executors, heirs and assigns. We expressly waive any rights we may have under California Civil Code 1542, which states, "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him/her might have materially affected his/her settlement with the debtor."

We agree that we indemnify and hold harmless **Kevin and Tanner Tweed and Coarsegold Rodeo/Grounds/Committee**, their owners, officers, directors, volunteers, members and agents against all claims, demands, and causes of action, including court costs and actual attorney fees, arising from any proceeding or lawsuits brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this release is upheld.

**Kevin and Tanner Tweed and Coarsegold Rodeo/Grounds/Committee**, its agents, volunteers or employees shall not be liable for any damage which may accrue from any cause or result of fire, theft, running away, state of health, injury to person, horse or property.

The undersigned has full power, authority, capacity and right without limitation to execute, deliver, and perform this release. We fully understand that any modifications, additions and/or deletions by myself to this release does not alter the express intent of this release.

### **MUTTON BUSTIN' RULES**

1. Mutton Bustin' will take place during, prior, or after the rodeo event each day (Saturday and Sunday). **Arrive 20 minutes prior to the Gate Opening** of your event day to make sure you are checked in on time.
2. There is a maximum of 12 entries per day, on a first come, first received basis. There will be no sign ups available at the event.
3. Entries, and payment of \$40 per rider, must be received by September 1, 2019.
4. Riders must be between the ages of 3-7 years, and not exceed 60 pounds in weight.
5. Riders are required to wear helmets and vests, which may be supplied by rider, or rider may use the available helmets and vests at the event.
6. Riders are to wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, and boots/shoes. No open-toe shoes are allowed.
7. No parents/guardians are allowed in the chutes; parents/guardians may be in the arena during their designated contest time.
8. All judges' decisions are final; judges are not to be approached.
